Dublin 2019, An Irish Worldcon Venue Rules

Please read this entire document before attending a Dublin 2019, An Irish Worldcon.

Attendees includes Committee, Staff, Volunteers and Members, and all others trading, exhibiting and otherwise participating.

Venue Staff includes all those directly, or indirectly through sub-contracting, employed by The Convention Centre, Dublin; the Point Square Shopping Centre, The Odeon Point Square; The Spencer Hotel; or The Gibson Hotel.

Compliance with the Venue Rules is mandatory for all attendees. Dublin 2019 and venue staff reserve the right to remove any attendee for a breach of these rules.

Food & Drink

- Only alcohol purchased on the premises can be consumed on the premises.
- Attendees can bring their own food and non-alcoholic drinks on site.
- Attendees are free to move around the venue with drinks but when using the lifts or escalators, to minimise the risk of spillages drinks must be in closed containers. (The Convention Centre, Dublin cannot allow open drinks on escalators for Health & Safety reasons.)
- The legal age limit in Ireland is 18 so anyone above this age can purchase and consume alcohol. Bar Staff will check ID of anyone who appears to be under the age of 21.
- Any breaches of these rules will cause the Convention Centre, Dublin's Security Team to ask attendees to leave the venue.

Smoking

- The venue is non-smoking.
- There is also no vaping in the venue.
- We have a smoking area outside the front door for both smokers and vapers.

Clothing

- Costumes are allowed.
- Attendees in large costumes must use the lift, rather than the escalators.
- It is not permitted to go barefoot anywhere in the venue.
- Costumes, and general clothing, must be decent and within the nudity laws of Ireland.

Admission

The Convention Centre, Dublin and Worldcon 2019, reserve the right to refuse admission for breach of these rules.
